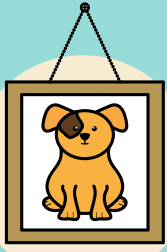


PET DISASTER KIT CHECKLIST

KEEP YOUR FUR-BABIES READY

Your kit should be easy to travel with and safe from water-damage



Picture of Your Pet

Updated, printed and digital copies of your pet, and microchip information



Leash & Collar

Collar with pet name and owner contact information



First Aid Kit

Bandages, Antiseptic Wipes, Heartworm, etc.



Medical & Vaccination Records

Up-to-date medical records for your pets, in a water safe bag



Medication

1 month supply of extra medication



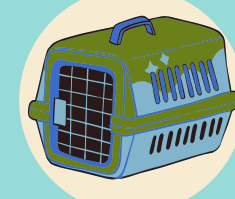
Hygiene Items

Shampoo, flea spray, etc.



Food & Water

Canned or dry food, and water for a 14-day supply



Pet Carrier

For easy transport of pet, with blankets



Tools

Manual can openers, gloves, flashlight, etc.



Non-Spill Food & Water Bowls



Comfort Items

Toys, Treats, Blankets to make your pet comfortable for a stressful situation



Poop Bags & Litter Boxes



Grooming Supplies

Able to assist in evacuation and in flood situations



Instructions

If you and your pet get separated leave instructions how to care for them



Mentions:

- Remember, having to evacuate with your pet it just as stressful for them as it is for you.
- Include your pet in your family emergency plan
- Practice transporting your pet in their carrier to get them familiar and comfortable with it
